What is a Byway?




Route Description

The River Bluffs Scenic Byway is a 109-mile driving route that takes travelers through 13 communities; with hiking and walking trails, recreational parks and rivers, wildlife management areas and historically significant places. The route takes about 4 hours to travel and winds through Clayton and Fayette Counties in northeast lowa.

lowa's Byways









Identify Historic Places








Get Lost in a Corn Maze




- A. This museum features history of the railroad & Marquette from the 1860s to present with railroad artifacts, pictures and souvenirs.
 - This barn allows visitors
 - to learn about what farming was like in the early 1900s.
- Here visitors can learn how lockmasters and their assistants lived as well as how the lock and dam system works and why it is needed.
- This national monument is home to over 200 burial mounds known as effigies, many of which are shaped like animals.




- This 18-room mansion built by the Carter brothers in 1855 is now a museum that shows how lowan's lived 150 years ago.
- Within this historical center, visitors can find farm tools, military items, books, treasures and stories of the families of Fayette County.






Tour the Grounds of Montauk




Enjoy the Colors of Autumn Leaves


The River Bluffs Scenic Byway is lined with sugar maple trees.

The sugar maple is best known for three things:


1. Colorful leaves that are seen in the fall each year. The leaves turn from green to bright colors like red, yellow & orange. Color the fall leaves below:





2. Helicopter seeds that whirl to the ground like a helicopter blade. Draw a helicopter seed below:



3. Maple Syrup that is made from sap stored in tree trunks. Draw a pancake with syrup below:








Find the Barn Quilts





Watch for colorful quilt designs hung on barns, corn cribs and other structures along the byway.


