

THE TURKEY RIVER RECREATIONAL CORRIDOR TRAIL



This section of the Turkey River Recreational Corridor Trail is 4.8 miles long and connects the communities of Clermont & Elgin to a variety of recreational activities & water trails.

As you continue on, we welcome you to the Turkey River Recreational Corridor, a joint effort between Clayton and Fayette Counties, and the communities of Clermont, Elgin and Elkader! This trail reveals and celebrates the natural beauty abounding in the Turkey River valley. For generations the Turkey River, with its wooded bluffs, fertile farmland and abundant wildlife attracted immigrants to the area. The Corridor features beautiful scenery, numerous historic landmarks, and unique cultural experiences nestled in the rural landscape.

The Turkey River Recreational Corridor trail serves as the backbone to a network of trail systems found in the region, providing visitors with outstanding recreational opportunities year round! The trail begins east of Nims Bridge and continues through the town of Clermont until it ends in the community of Elgin. Whether you choose to spend time on a bicycle or horseback, experience the water trail by tube, canoe or kayak, shop, golf, hike, or just exploring the back roads along the River Bluffs Scenic Byway from your car, you will find multiple ways to kick back and relax.
